## CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS

### GLOBAL LEADERSHIP GROUP WORKSHOP

#### Overview:

Our framework for opportunity creation is grounded in creating equity vehicles that make equality possible. In many instances, institutional barriers to these opportunities have to be overcome by scaling them instead of knocking them down. This exercise is all about giving teachers and their students the most important skills in leadership, empathy, networking, culturally relevant pedagogy/learning and computational literacy.

While there are hundreds of leadership philosophies, they mostly put leaders (and what makes leaders great) into several categories: advocates, resource connectors, think tanks/thought partners and campaign builders.

The training allows for both the teachers and the students to identify and develop one or all attributes. Through active learning, students will gain the skills and loved experiences that will some day support their barrier scaling while teachers learn how they can be better tools for equities and rungs on the opportunity ladders.

#### Activity:

In 2015, the United Nations announced a list of 17 Global Development Goals to drive equitable opportunities and innovation creation. These goals guide the world's mission to eradicate poverty and hunger, protect the planet, and ensure prosperity for all. For the goals to be reached, everyone needs to do their part: governments, the private sector, civil society, students and educators. Through this exercise, students and teachers will assume a leadership role in sparking change. They will work in groups to identity their own personal, community and school development goals and produce an action plan to contribute to a sustainable future.

#### TOOLS FOR INTENTIONAL EXCELLENCE

The famous Greek philosopher Aristotle stated, "We are what we repeatedly do. Excellence, then, is not an act, but a habit." The quest for excellence must be guided by intentional thought, action and understanding. This workshop is designed to develop the leadership capacity of students by filling their toolboxes with the tools necessary to empower their ability to succeed, lead and operate at a sustained level of excellence. The session explores concepts such as vision casting, self-esteem, personal responsibility and effective communication to help build confidant and competent future leaders.







# CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS (continued)

### ENTREPRENEURISM WORKSHOP

On February 27, 2014, President Barack Obama launched the "My Brother's Keeper" (MBK) Initiative, a call to action to address persistent opportunity gaps faced by boys and young men of color and ensure all young people can reach their full potential. In February 2016, the Administration announced the creation of new STEM and entrepreneurship tracks within MBK. A number of community organizations were selected as community partners and challenged to expand STEM and entrepreneurship opportunities in various communities. The McMikle Group was named as one of those community partners. This workshop was born out of that commitment.

The entrepreneur workshop is an introduction to the concept of business ownership that will allow students to gain an understanding of entrepreneurism as a viable career choice and motivate movement towards a greater exploration of that reality.


